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Title: Medicaid Adult Day Health Care Services

Ineligible Individuals:

In accordance with 13 CSR 70-92.010, individuals who reside in a long-term residential care facility licensed by the Division of Aging or the Department of Mental Health, are not eligible for adult day health care services.

ACTION:

- ✓ Do not refer individuals who reside in a DMH licensed facility to Division of Senior Services for adult day health care services;
- ✓ If it comes to the attention of regional center staff that adult day health care services were initially authorized for an individual after January, 2003, notify the County Division of Senior Services office and coordinate the termination of the services. This may also require an alternate service being authorized by regional center staff.

Eligible Individuals:

Adult day health care services are available to individuals served by DMRDD under the following circumstances:

- 1) The person meets the general eligibility criteria for adult day health care services; and
 - a.) The person is not in placement and is living with family, or a living arrangement that is not licensed by DMH or Division of Senior Services (formerly Division of Aging); or
 - b.) The person is living in an ISL arrangement certified, but not licensed by DMH, and the ISL budget does not cover 24-hour care or otherwise duplicate adult day health care service coverage.
